- When typing the narrative please consider the 50 words or less rule. We will not count (a, it, is, etc...). It should include descriptive words and other club involvements and it should only cover the time period mentioned above. **This should be typed.**
- Your Club will determine the judging criteria and you will submit your “Citizen of the Year” name and narrative to the Chairman, Cruz Baca.

**The name of the member chosen must be in the hands of the District Chairman on or before March 12, 2021. Due Date**
